Sciob




#### What is it?

A *sciob* was a type of basket. The *sciob* in the NMI Handling Collection was made by Joe Hogan, Loch na Fooey, County Galway. It is made from willow or sally-rods.

### What was it used for?

While it was used for many different carrying purposes in and around the house, it was designed as a potato strainer.





Basketmakers' preferred material was willow. In some areas where willow was scarce, other materials were used to make baskets, such as briars or dock stems.

# Brief History

At a time when all the cooking for the family and the livestock was done over the open fire, potatoes were boiled in a large cast-iron pot known as a skillet.

The potatoes were drained using the *sciob* as a strainer. Placed on the skillet, the steam from the pot below helped to keep the potatoes warm. In tight spaces everyone gathered around the sciob and ate their meal directly from it.
